Chairman's Report – Full Council 5.7.17

- The Local Plan – Stansted has a proposed allocation of 62 houses – the preferred strategy is for Garden Communities to be established by 2033
 - Easton Park 1,880
 - West of Braintree 1,800
 - North Uttlesford 1,900Consultation on this proposal will be between 12th July and 1st September (the school holidays!)

- Elms Farm – Ruth consulted the developer (Crest Nicholson) and UDC in relation to the concerns re the current earthworks and the view seen from Chapel Hill – everything is in line with the permissions granted and the view will remain unchanged from the original consent. We will however, continue to pursue the developer to ensure the landscaping of the area concerned is in keeping with the quality of the surrounding area.

- SSE is to be invited to talk to Council re the proposed airport expansion application – we hope this will be the next meeting.

- France – Ruth, myself, Peter James and Martin Budzinski, as well as Mr Sautron, Head of Modern Foreign Languages from FH School will be visiting Rungis tomorrow and Friday to meet the Maire and the Council of the city. We have made sure our accommodation and travel are economy rate, with the business forum and the school paying for their representatives. Consultation will be progressed on our return when we have a better picture of the benefits for us of a twinning arrangement.

- Elsenham School - A Public consultation on the provision of additional primary school places at the Elsenham C of E school will take place at the school on July 12th between 2 and 7 pm for those wishing to attend.

- Community Day at Forest Hall School – this has become an annual event with pupils helping out around the village. Trevor organised several

different groups who undertook such tasks as clearing weeds around the Windmill (with Molly Clark) and our car park, litter-picked with Lucy, minor maintenance with Lee, distributing some of our leaflets etc. etc. Feedback received from Lucy and Lee was very positive.

Allegations about the governance and licensing of a new pharmacy at the above location have been brought to my attention.

It has been alleged that the pharmacy is operating incorrectly under a license at a premises in South London that do not belong to the same legal entity/company. Staff at the premises recently confirmed to me that they do not hold a local license. They are prescribing at Stansted but applying South London labels to their prescriptions.

Is this not both irregular and putting at risk the safety of patients? To whom would one seek recourse in the event of a prescribing error?

I seek your urgent confirmation of the action that the NHS is taking to establish whether the pharmacy is performing within the law and that you will take prompt action if it is not.
