### How to CAST your VOTE?



### Things to bear in mind...

### Wear a mask

unless you are exempt, otherwise you will not be allowed to vote. Also observe the safety precautions at polling station to limit the spread of Covid-19 — eg follow one-way systems, use the hand gel provided, and respect social distancing

### Avoid busy times

if possible, particularly 6-8pm as well at the start/end of the school day where an education setting acts as a polling station

### Don't panic

if you misplace your poll card. You will still get to vote so long as your registered details can be verified by election officials

### No pics, please

The Electoral Commission strongly discourages any photos (or tweeting) in polling stations, as it may compromise someone's right to vote in secret. Even accidentally revealing a person's voting choice may result in a fine of £5000.



If you are a registered voter, you will have received a Poll card from Uttlesford District Council. On it is detailed the election date, type of election, hours of voting, and prescribed polling station (see below).



Show your poll card at your polling station and give your name and address. Election officials will verify your details and issue you with your ballot papers.



Go to a voting booth and mark against the candidate's name you wish to vote for. Put your ballot paper into the ballot box.



### WHERE CAN YOU VOTE?

Where you live in the village will determine where you cast your vote, as Stansted is split into a north and a south ward. There are two polling stations for the North ward, and one for the South. In both wards, polling stations will be open from 7am to 10pm tomorrow.
